Principal's report

Dear Parents and Caregivers,



For the past week and a half I have had the privilege of relieving as Principal while Mr Goh is in London on a NSW Department of Education scholarship for the Best Principals' Program. This is a very prestigious award and Mr Goh will be visiting schools in the UK to observe and learn from their best practice. The Merrylands East Public School staff congratulate Mr Goh on this achievement.

We have now completed our Kindergarten Orientation program and were pleased with the number of parents who were able to attend with their children.
