#### Celebrating the Magic of Reading during Book Week!

At Merrylands East Public School, we believe that reading truly is magic. The assessment helps teachers tailor instruction to meet the needs of each student, ensuring that every child is on the path to becoming a confident, fluent reader. We're proud of the effort and determination our Year 1 students have shown during this assessment, and we look forward to continuing to support them on their reading journey.

#### **Managing Costs for Families**

We understand the costs of living can be financially challenging for many families. Despite a reduced school budget in 2024, we have made a concerted effort to minimize or eliminate costs for excursions, extracurricular programs, and PSSA sports. While this has meant making some difficult decisions - such as pausing the gymnastics program for K-3 in Term 4 - we hope to resume these activities in Term 1 of 2025. We remain committed to providing enriching experiences for our students while being mindful of the financial pressures on our community.

#### **Kindy Enrolments for 2025**

Merrylands East Public School is accepting Kindergarten enrolments for 2025. To be eligible to enrol, students need to be turning 5 years old by 31 July 2025.

For enrolment purposes, you will require proof of age (birth certificate or passport), proof of citizenship (passport, citizenship certificate or visa documents), proof of residential address (a gas or electricity bill, rate notice or a lease agreement), and immunisation history from Medicare. Original documents need to be shown to the office after the online enrolment is complete.
